

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

TOWN OF FARMVILLE
CODE OF ORDINANCES
CHAPTER 20 - SANITATION AND HEALTH



Whereas, _____ (address of violator) did:

- a) Fail to comply with Chapter 20, Sanitation and Health Ordinance by:
- i. Not removing waste containers from curbside after collection of waste or
 - ii. Placing waste material improperly in the inappropriate waste container or
 - iii. Using a waste container that is not approved by the Town.

Whereby, Town of Farmville recently published article in the Towns Monthly Utility Newsletter (January, 2005) with an additional reminder in the April, 2005 Utility Newsletter giving all citizens and businesses notice of Town Code of Ordinance, Chapter 20, Sanitation and Health regarding waste containers not removed from curbside after collection.

By immediate notice, the owner must:

1. remove all waste containers, including recyclable and yard waste containers, from the curbside the same day waste collection has been picked up.
2. not leave any waste containers by the curbside unless it is their scheduled day for pickup.
3. not use recyclable or brown yard waste containers as additional storage for waste.
4. place all waste containers behind residence or in a location screened from public view as stated in Chapter 20, 1.2.3 Garbage Collection.
5. obtain a Town approved waste container.

Failure to comply, will result in penalties provided for violation of this code as stated in the Code of Ordinance, Chapter 20, Sanitation and Health, 1.7 Administration.
