This chart is compiled from data transmitted to the North Carolina Department of Justice on a monthly basis. Utilizing North Carolina Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) standards, these statistics are compiled for nearly every city and county in the state. In doing so, the same standards for reporting apply to every agency and city regardless of size or population. Lastly, a simple mathematical process is used to reflect a crime index regardless of population. Generally, the "Crime Index" represents the number of reportable crimes which occurred for each 100,000 in population.
